Behavior of a Potential Criminal Assailant

- 1. Will establish ideal hunting grounds and find a casual surveillance point
- 2. Will begin profiling you
  - Will try to determine relative strength (mental and physical) and potential risk of resistance
  - Will follow you, matching your walking speed
- 3. Before making contact, will look around for potential witnesses
- 4. Will look for a potential ambush point
  - Low visibility
  - Low risk of discovery
- 5. Immediately prior to the attack, will enter your personal safe zone
  - Six foot diameter circle
