What is a Predator?

- 1. Criminal
- 2. Bully
- 3. Obnoxious Drunk

What Does a Predator Look For?

- 1. Someone weaker than they are
- 2. Perceived physical strength and personality makeup

Personality Types

- 1. Confrontational Personality
 - Unpleasant to deal with because they are either loudly obnoxious or overtly hostile
- 2. Assertive Personality
 - High self-confidence; at ease socially, but capable of projecting verbal/ nonverbal resistance when necessary
- 3. Defensive Personality
 - Normally non-aggressive and slow to anger; when cornered, or when (s)he feels the need to defend a third party, will quickly become confrontational
- 4. Passive Personality
 - Uniformly quiet and shy; gives impression of being meek; ideal as a victim because they will tolerate being victimized
